AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Pursuant to the order dated 15.11.2019, an affidavit of Sh. Amarjeet Singh, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, (in CRM-M-38954-2019), has been filed in Court today by learned State counsel, stating eventually therein that upon inquiry conducted by the DSP Bagha Purana, it was found that the petitioner, Jaspreet Singh (in CRM-M-38954-2019), did not in fact initially give any video clip to the investigating officer, but upon the video clip having then been produced, other persons have been nominated as accused in the case.

With it again to be repeated that it is difficult to believe that the petitioner would produce a video clip in this Court and not give it to the investigating officer, but be that as it may, since learned State counsel on instructions from the DSP who is present in Court submits that the petitioners in these petitions have joined investigation, pursuant to the order dated 13.09.2019 and presently their custodial interrogation is not required, the interim order dated 13.09.2019, passed by this Court, in these petitions, is made absolute, on the same terms and conditions.

However, this order will not be treated to be an observation of this court on the merits of the case, but only in view of the fact that the investigating agency itself has stated that it does not require custodial interrogation of the petitioners.

Naturally, the complainant would be at liberty to avail of his remedy as legally available, as regards any grievance, including the investigation process.

The petitions are disposed of accordingly.
