Petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents to correct the marks given to him in the written examination, which was conducted for the post of Patwari.

Pursuant to the order dated 24.01.2018, petitioner had appeared before the respondent-Commission on 29.01.2018, where he was shown his original OMR sheet. He tallied the answers marked on original OMR sheet and Candidate copy with the revised answer key and found 74 answers right. With regard to the said fact, he made a statement and signed the same on the same day.

Today, final result of the petitioner has been produced in Court, a perusal of which shows that he has secured 148 marks in the written examination and 12 in interview, total 160 marks. The answer sheet of the petitioner has been rightly marked. Last candidate in the waiting list has

secured 164 marks. Hence, the petitioner has secured less marks than the last candidate. Therefore, he is not eligible to be selected for the aforesaid post.

Resultantly, the present petition is dismissed. OMR sheet and the report of respondent-Commission is being returned back.
