Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.100,
dated 15.3.2019, registered under Section 302 IPC, at Police Station City
HTM, Hisar.

Wife of the petitioner had died and her brother had
lodged the present FIR with the allegations that the petitioner used to give
her beatings and the petitioner had been giving beatings to Sonia (deceased)
for the last 4-5 days before her death.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, as per the

post mortem report, there was no injury on the body of the deceased. The petitioner is in custody since 16.3.2019.

Learned counsel for the State is unable to dispute the above position.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid fact that the petitioner is in custody since 16.3.2019, and the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
