Pursuant to the order dated 18.09.2019, the petitioner is stated to have joined investigation, with learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Manohar Lal, submitting that even a compromise has been effected between the parties, though an offence punishable under Section 325 of IPC was later added in the FIR, in respect of which the petitioner was not granted bail by the learned Sessions Judge.

Though otherwise the petitioner may not be entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail, looking at his role alleged in the FIR, however, as learned State counsel has submitted that in fact a compromise has been effected between the parties, the petition is disposed of, with the interim order dated 18.09.2019, admitting the petitioner to interim bail, made absolute.
