RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for respondent No.4-Insurance Company submits that there is no scope of enhancement in as much as appellants-claimants have already been awarded much more compensation than their legal entitlement. That apart, learned tribunal illegally added 50% to the income of the deceased towards future prospects which could not have been more than 40% in view of the settled proposition of law laid down in **National Insurance Company Ltd. Vs. Pranay Sethi and others, 2017 (4) RCR (Civil) 1009.**

Perusal of the file shows that after filing of this appeal in the year 2017, it has been taken on board for five times. However, none of the occasions, appellants or their counsel came present. Hence, it is apparent that appellants and their counsel knowing very well that they have already been awarded compensation in excess, are not interested in pursuing the instant appeal.

In view of above, the instant appeal stands dismissed for want of prosecution.
