TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners seek issuance of a mandamus for directing the official respondents to take necessary steps for protection of their life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 18.

Petitioner No.1 is stated to be aged 30 years. She is married to Bhupinder Singh/respondent No.4. Three children were born out of the wedlock.

Apparently, the petitioner No.1 has abandoned her matrimonial home and is now in a live-in-relationship with petitioner No.2 who is almost 10 years younger to her.

The three minor children have been left to be taken care by their father/respondent No.4.

Under no circumstances would this Court approve of such a relationship/liaison.

Be that as it may, pleadings on record are wholly insufficient to infer any imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

No intervention in the matter is called for.

Petition is dismissed.
