In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the suspension period of the petitioner from 05.01.2011 to 13.04.2011 and thereafter 19.07.2013 till 09.02.2014 is required to be decided, keeping in view the provisions of Rule 7.3 A of the Punjab Civil Services Rules Volume 1 Part 1 after the petitioner has been exonerated of the allegations and order dismissing the petitioner from service has already been recalled and the petitioner has already retired from service.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the prayer of the petitioner in the present writ petition is for directing the respondents for passing of appropriate orders for deciding the suspension period, keeping in view, Rule 7.3 A of Punjab Civil Services Rules Volume 1 Part 1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that for the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, petitioner has submitted with respondent No.1 representation dated 11.06.2019(Annexure P-10), which is still pending consideration with respondent No.1 and the petitioner will be satisfied, at

No.1 to decide the said representation.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and the claim being made by the petitioner, the respondent No.1 is directed to decide the representation dated 11.06.2019(Annexure P-10), by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
