The petitioner filed a writ petition seeking a direction for grant of revised pension and pensionary benefits after counting military service rendered by him during the first and second national emergencies. The writ petition was allowed on 15.11.2018 with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 8.10.2018.

The present petition is filed pleading that needful has not been done.

Learned counsel for the State has produced order dated 13.12.2019 wherein the claim of the petitioner has been accepted and his service rendered in military for 5 years, 2 months and 7 days has been counted and accordingly pension and pensionary benefits are revised. He,

on instructions from Ms. Sulekha Rani, Senior Assistant, O/o Social Security Women & Child Development, Punjab submits that monetary benefits arising as a result of the order dated 13.12.2019 would be credited in the account of the petitioner within three months from today.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of.

In case the statement made today in Court is not adhered to, the petitioner shall be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.
