During the pendency of the instant appeal, a settlement was arrived at between the parties. An application was moved for converting the present appeal into one under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act. This prayer was allowed vide order dated 8.7.2019. Statements of the parties at first motion were recorded on 9.7.2019 and the matter was adjourned. Today, both the parties have appeared and made their statements at second motion by way of their affidavits. The same have been taken on record as Exs.P1 and P2. As all parameters envisaged by judgment in **Amardeep Singh v. Harveen Kaur (2017) 8 SCC 746** are met, this court accepts the plea for divorce by mutual consent by waiving off statutory period of six months' between first motion and second motion. The marriage between the parties is, thus, dissolved by a decree of divorce by mutual consent. Decree sheet be drawn up accordingly.
