The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 99 dated 25.08.2019, registered under Sections 379 and 411 of the IPC at Police Station Cantt., Bathinda, District Bathinda.

The operative part of the order dated 18.09.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that as per the allegations in the FIR, the police received a secret information that two persons are roaming on a stolen motorcycle. Thereafter, the police arrested co-accused Sukhjeet Singh @ Gaggu from the spot by conducting a raid and recovered the stolen motorcycle.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further argues that the name of the petitioner surfaced on the disclosure of aforesaid co-accused Sukjeet Singh @ Gaggu, however, the petitioner has nothing to do with the said co-accused as he is nominated in this case on account of the fact that on a previous occasion, the petitioner had an altercation

with a police official who was in the inebriated condition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is not involved in any other case and he is ready to join investigation.

Adjourned to 15.10.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 18.09.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Gurcharan Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 18.09.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
