1. Seen office report.
2. Ld. Counsel for the appellant has been informed vide this Court's letter No.2947 dated 25.02.2019.
3. Perusal of the record makes it clear that the appellant is not interested to pursue this appeal. Since the very first date, after notice was ordered to be issued (10.05.2012), adjournments have been consistently sought on behalf of the appellant. There were stringent observations made against this attitude of the appellant in the subsequent orders dated 21.03.2016, 31.05.2016 and 30.01.2017. Thereafter on 13.07.2017, Ld. Counsel for the appellant informed that his client had expired and his Legal Representatives were sought to be brought on the record.
4. No steps in this regard have been taken for more than 1½ years now.

5. In the circumstances, the appeal stands abated with liberty, however, to have the same revived, if, so sought for on behalf of the Legal Representatives of the appellant, in future.
