The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.61 dated 17.08.2019, registered under Sections 447, 511, 353, 186, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Joga, District Mansa.

The operative part of the order dated 12.09.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioners, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were not named in the FIR and their names surfaced after the disclosure of a co-accused.

Notice of motion for 03.10.2019....”

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 12.09.2019, the petitioners have appeared before the Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurdev

Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 12.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
