Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.88 dated 30.07.2019 under Sections 447, 336, 427, 307 (added later on) IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Khui Khera, District Fazilka.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 12.09.2019: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is the wife of the complainant and as per the allegations in the FIR, the complainant has transferred 4.5 acres of land in favour of the petitioner, out of which, she has agreed to sell 5 Kanals of said

land to one Jarnail Singh and on that account, the dispute has arisen between them...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the orders dated 12.09.2019 and 01.10.2019, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Darshan Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 12.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
