Counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length and pleadings on record have been perused.

Averments made in the petition are wholly insufficient for this Court to infer any imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Rather pleadings on record would suggest that there is a certain dispute with regard to a plot measuring 1 kanal 16 marlas that had been purchased by the petitioner in an open auction conducted by the Govt. of Punjab. There are certain allegations being made by the official respondents as regards the petitioner having facilitated such purchase on the strength of false and fabricated documents. Even if that be so petitioner in law would have a civil remedy available for protection of his rights pertaining to the immovable property.

No intervention in the instant petition is warranted.

Dismissed.
