RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (ORAL)

Learned counsel appearing for the respondents submits that the advertisement pursuant to which the appellant had applied for allotment of retail outlet on 16.09.2010 has outlived its life and shall no longer be acted upon, more so as the respondents have already granted another outlet pursuant to subsequent advertisement at a nearby place in the same stretch.

In view of the aforesaid, we do not find any reason to keep this appeal pending or enter into the merits of the case as the issue raised therein has been rendered infructuous with the efflux of time.

We accordingly dispose of the appeal by observing that the appellant would be at liberty to apply afresh pursuant to any fresh advertisement issued by the respondents and in case the appellant does so,

his case be considered on merit in accordance with the guidelines prevailing

at that time without being influenced by the observations made by the learned Single Judge in the impugned order dated 17.07.2014.
