Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.187 dated 30.08.2019 registered under Sections 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and 61(1) of the Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

As per case of the prosecution, 16,250 intoxicating tablets containing Tramadol salt and 80 litres of lahan were recovered from the farm house.

The crime alleged is heinous in nature. Hence, there is no ground to grant concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
