Application is allowed as prayed for. The accompanying  
rent agreement dated 30.08.2019 is taken on record as Annexure P-3.

**CWP No.25464 of 2019**

Learned State counsel has filed in Court today a short reply  
by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub  
Division Barnala along with Annexures R-1/T to R-10/T. The same is  
taken on record and a complete copy has been furnished to counsel  
opposite.

The petitioner is seeking a Mandamus for directing the  
official respondents for protection of her life and liberty by voicing an  
apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private  
respondents No.4 to 13.

Para 4 of the reply filed in Court today reads in the  
following terms :-

“4. That Gurpreet Singh, Sandeep Singh, Jiwan Singh, Kala Singh, Malkiat Singh, Jagsir Singh (respondents No.6,8,9,10,11 and 13) have also furnished their respective affidavits dated 24.9.2019 duly attested by Notary Barnala and in their respective affidavit, all the above said private respondents corroborated the version made by each to the effect that Sukhdeep Kaur has solemnized marriage Abhishek Kumar son of Suresh Kumar R/o Gali No.12 Ramgarhia Road, Barnala, Sukhdeep Kaur is major, who is able, to think about her good or bad and wherever she wants to live after marriage she may live and in this regard they have no objection and also will have no objection in future. They further stated that Sukhdeep Kaur after performing marriage with boy Abhishek Kumar son of Suresh Kumar has demanded police protection, however, either they nor they family member ever harassed her before this and will also not harassed her in future and that they have furnished their respective affidavits without any kind of pressure, but with their solid state of mind and free will. Both Sukhdeep Kaur and Abhishek Kumar after performing marriage, wherever they want to live may live for which they or their family members have no objection. True translated copies of affidavits of Gurpreet Singh, Sandeep Singh, Jiwan Singh, Kala Singh, Malkiat Singh and Jagsir Singh (respondents No.6,8,9,10, 11 and 12) are

annexed as Anenxure R-3/T to R-9/T. The said ASI also recorded joint statement of 8 respectable persons residents of the said Mohalla who stated that Suresh Kumar, his wife Sunita and son Abhishek left their house last about one month and went to some disclose place and their whereabouts is not known to anybody, where they at present residing nor they telephonic call has been received to any of them.”

In view of the above, the apprehension voiced by the petitioner as regards the threat to her life and liberty stands redressed.

No further directions are required to be passed.

Writ petition is disposed of.
