TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)

The instant petition was filed on 10.09.2019 jointly at the hands of Resham Singh and Poonam seeking a Mandamus for directing the official respondents to take appropriate steps for protection of their life and liberty.

The case projected was that both the petitioners are in a live-in relationship which is not acceptable to their respective families and elders and under such circumstances they fear for their life.

Petitioner No.2, namely Poonam has appeared in person and is duly identified by counsel as also by ASI Sukhdev Chand, Police Station Basti Bawa Khel, Jalandhar. A categoric statement has been made by petitioner No.2 in Court that she now wishes to stay separately from petitioner No.1 and as such does not wish to pursue the instant petition.

Petitioner No.1 Resham Singh is also present in person.
This Court having interacted with Resham Singh is satisfied that both the petitioners as of now do not wish to stay together. Allegations/counter-allegations are being raised by the petitioners against each other.

Be that as it may, no directions are required to be passed in the instant writ petition. Same is disposed of.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
