Prayer in this application is for disposing of FAO No.3037 of 2017 as dispute between the appellants/claimants and insurance company has been settled by way of compromise and in view of the settlement, insurance company has agreed to pay a sum of Rs.4 lakh over and above compensation assessed by the Tribunal.

Counsel for the non-applicants/appellants concedes to this position.

In view of the above, application is allowed. FAO No.3037 of 2017 is taken on Board today itself.

FAO No.3037 of 2017

Dispute between the parties has been settled by way of compromise. The appeal stands disposed of in terms of the compromise. The insurance company shall deposit additional amount of Rs.4 lakh to be paid to the claimants over and above compensation

allowed by the Tribunal in the name of minor Krishana Nayak daughter of late Santosh Kumar Nayak @ Lambyu with the Permanent Lok Adalat of this Court within 30 days and the same shall be converted into fixed deposit payable on her attaining majority or for a period of 3 years, whichever is later.
