Having heard learned counsel for the applicants as well as the
learned state counsel the order dated 19.07.2019 is modified and the same shall
be read as below:

“After hearing the arguments, the writ petition is
dismissed with liberty to seek appropriate remedy in
accordance with the law for adjudication of the pending
disputes between the erstwhile owner of the mill of which
petitioner Company is successor-in-interest.

The disputed facts involved herein cannot be
adjudicated under extraordinary writ jurisdiction by this
Court and therefore, Article 226 is wrongly invoked herein.
Dismissed with liberty as aforesaid.”
