DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he does not press the present petition. However, he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the First Appellate Court to decide in a time bound manner, the appeal filed by respondent No.1 against the judgment and decree of the Trial Court dated 17.11.2014 in Civil Suit No. 82 of 2013, “Nachhattar Singh and others vs. Makhan Singh and another”.

The alternate prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners is found to be reasonable especially in view of the fact that respondent No.1's appeal is pending for the last over 4 years. A direction to dispose of a *lis* between the parties would also prejudice none.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a

direction to the First Appellate Court to finally dispose of the appeal filed by respondent No.1 against the judgment and decree of the Trial Court dated 17.11.2014 within three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, in accordance with law.

If the respondent No.1 is aggrieved by this order, he is at liberty to approach this Court by filling of an appropriate application.
