The petitioners filed a writ petition seeking direction to respondents to calculate the service rendered by them with PUNWAC before they were absorbed in the Government Department.

The petition was disposed of on 19.12.2018 with the direction to the competent authority to pass an appropriate order. The needful was to be done within two months from receipt of the certified copy of order. It was further ordered that in case the petitioners were found entitled to any monetary benefits, the same be released within one month thereafter.

Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the respondents have passed an order whereby the claim of the petitioners has been partly accepted.

The grievance raised by learned counsel for the petitioners is that monetary benefits has not been released till date.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Jagraj Singh, Junior Assistant, O/o Department of Social Security and Development of Women and Children, Punjab, submits that the matter is under active consideration and the amounts would be credited in the account of the petitioners within six weeks from today.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty to avail remedy in case the grievance still survives.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for. In case, the payment is not made within six weeks, the petitioner shall be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.
