Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter-alia*, contends that Promotion Policy (Annexure P-2) drafted by respondent No.2-Institute is mandatorily required to be approved by Ministry of Human Resources and Development, Government of India. Perusal of the paper-book reflects that even though it is averred that Promotion Policy is in violation of notification dated 04.08.2010 issued by Department of Personnel and Training, Government of India, but there is no formal challenge to the said policy and merely a recruitment notice dated 30.08.2019 (Annexure P-7) has been challenged which is stated to be in pursuance to the Promotion Policy (Annexure P-2). Further more, no provision has been mentioned under which Promotion Policy is required to be approved by Ministry of Human Resources and Development.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file the same with better particulars along with liberty to challenge the promotion policy, if so advised.

Dismissed with the liberty as prayed for.
