By this petition filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail'.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced in court today a certified copy of the testimony of the complainant in the FIR, i.e. Satpal Singla, on 29.11.2019, stating to the effect that though he had got the FIR registered, however, he had not got a supplementary statement recorded (as contained therein) and he did not identify the “persons present in the court being accused”.

He was thereafter declared to be hostile, with him having again stated the same thing in his cross-examination by the Public Prosecutor.

The said copy of the testimony is ordered to be taken on record.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, for or against the petitioner, the present petition is allowed.

The petitioner would be enlarged on bail, upon his furnishing
adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
