Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.28 dated 05.05.2019 under Sections 380, 457 IPC, registered at Police Station Purana Shalla, District Gurdaspur.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 13.09.2019: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on an earlier occasion, the petitioner was involved in similar case/FIR, on account of previous enmity with his uncle and later on, the said FIR was cancelled. It is further submitted that the complainant is neighbour of the petitioner and the FIR has been registered after a delay of 13 days and the petitioner has been falsely implicated.

Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is an old case of viral Hepatitis and needs medical treatment...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Amrik Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 13.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
