Petitioner prays for bail pending trial in criminal case arising from FIR No. 51 dated 18.5.2019 registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 294, 364, 357, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Sri Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner was not himself armed and had only instigated the other co-accused to inflict injuries. Petitioner is in custody for almost 6 months.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Naseem Khan has submitted that on completion of the investigations, police report under Section 173 Cr.P.C has been filed. Therefore, the petitioner is now in judicial custody.

Keeping in view the facts of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, it is considered appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail on his furnishing fresh bail and

surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.
