The instant petition has been filed praying for a Mandamus for directing the official respondents to take necessary steps for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of respondent no.4.

Counsel has been heard at length and case paper book has been perused.

Pleadings on record would show that petitioner no.1 is 32 years old and is married to respondent no.4. Out of the wedlock two children were born. She apparently has abandoned her matrimonial home and is now stated to be in a live-in relationship with petitioner no.2, who is 11 years younger.

On a query having been put, counsel would concede that the two minor children born out of the wedlock have also been left behind and to be looked after by respondent no.4.

This Court, under no circumstances can approve of such conduct at the hands of the petitioners.

Even otherwise, pleadings on record are wholly insufficient to infer any imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

No intervention is called for.

Petition is dismissed.
