1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the impugned order dated 29.07.2019 (P-1) passed by the Commissioner, Karnal Division, Karnal whereby the claim of the petitioner for grant of agricultural parole had been rejected by the respondents.

2. The petitioner was convicted and sentenced to undergo life imprisonment in case FIR No.83 dated 01.04.2004, under Sections 460, 34 IPC and 25 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Chandni Bagh, District Panipat. Appeal filed by the petitioner against conviction and sentence has been dismissed by this Court.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the request of the petitioner for grant of parole for agricultural operations has been rejected only on the apprehension shown by the local police that if the petitioner is released on parole, he may abscond and there is possibility of breach of

peace in the village.

4. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, I am of the view that no ground for interference in the impugned order is made out. The case of the petitioner has been rejected by the Commissioner, Karnal Division, Karnal on the report of the District Magistrate, Palwal. The District Magistrate has gone by the opinion of the Superintendent of Police, Palwal, who has reported that the petitioner has only land measuring 2 kanals and there are 10 members in his family who can carry out the task. There is no illegality or infirmity in the impugned order dated 29.07.2019 (P-1) passed by respondent No.2.

5. Dismissed accordingly at this stage.
