The petitioner prays for concession of regular bail in FIR No.66 dated 29.05.2019, registered under Sections 323, 324, 307, 427, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station Nurpur, District Roopnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is attributed injury with *kirch* on the back of the injured but the same is not supported by the medical evidence. He further submits that all the injuries are simple in nature. He further contends that the petitioner is in custody since 19.06.2019.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the investigations are complete and final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been filed.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case and after keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, it would be appropriate to direct the petitioner to be released on regular bail.

Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing adequate surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/

Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
