The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.1204 dated 18.12.2018 under Sections 201, 346, 304, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Central Faridabad, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. He has been arraigned as an accused as the deceased had made a call from the mobile of the petitioner to his wife that he is with the brother of the petitioner, namely, Bijender. He also contends that the deceased after consuming liquor had fallen from the roof of the petitioner's house. The petitioner and co-accused Bijender had taken him to private hospital, namely, Shanti Devi Memorial Hospital from where he was referred to some other hospital but on his way to the hospital, he expired. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody for about one year and the complainant has been examined, who has not named the petitioner as responsible for the death of the deceased. The complainant has referred to two other co-accused, who were responsible for the death of his brother.

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Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sunil Kumar, states that 08 out of 24 prosecution witnesses have been examined. He, however, is not in a position to controvert the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for about one year and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
