Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.80 dated 13.08.2019 under Sections 420, 465, 466, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Ramdass, District Amritsar Rural.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 13.09.2019: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, registered on a complaint given by one Varinderjit Kaur against co-accused Piar Kaur, she had entered into an agreement to sell her land, with the complainant and after giving the earnest money, it came to notice of the complainant that

the land, in fact, belongs to Govt. and Piar Kaur is not the true owner. It is further submitted that in the FIR, there is no reference of the petitioner and he is neither any beneficiary of the alleged agreement to sell nor he has signed any document. Learned counsel further submits that on an earlier occasion, the petitioner has given a complaint against husband of complainant Varinderjit Kaur and on that account, he is nominated in the present FIR...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harjeet Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 13.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
