TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners seek a mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect their life and liberty as they apprehend danger to the same at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6.

During the course of arguments, it has come forth that petitioner No.2 is aged 33 years and was already married to a lady, namely, Shehnaz. Out of wedlock four children were born.

Petitioner No.2 has now parted company with his wife and has chosen to stay with petitioner No.1.

Petitioner No.2 is present in Court and has been identified through counsel.

Court having interacted with petitioner No.2, he concedes that his wife, namely, Shehnaz has no source of income and has been left alone with four minor children.

This Court under no circumstances can approve of such liaison between the petitioners. That apart, pleadings on record are insufficient to infer any imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

No intervention is called for.

Dismissed.
