Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Kapil Bansal, DAG, Haryana, who is deputed to Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and waives service on them.

Vide order dated 05.09.2019, the Commissioner, Karnal Division, Karnal has granted 07 days parole to the petitioner for house repair which period has turned out to be inadequate for the task involved. The petitioner has prayed for extension of time.

Having heard Mr. Virk and Mr. Bansal and taking into consideration the request of the petitioner, I am of the view that the period of 07 days granted by the Commissioner was insufficient to carry out effective house repairs and the same ought to have been extended by a further period of 03 weeks.

In view thereof, while allowing the instant petition, the parole period granted to the petitioner is ordered to be extended by 03 weeks on

usual terms and conditions imposed by the competent authority. The petitioner shall surrender himself before the Jail Authorities on 07.10.2019 before 4.00 PM.

Petition stands allowed accordingly.
