As per report received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this court, the matter has been settled between the parties vide Settlement/Compromise dated 11.04.2019.

A perusal of the Settlement/Compromise dated 11.04.2019 would reflect that both the parties have amicably settled their differences and in view of the said compromise, it has been agreed that the instant regular second appeal as well as the cross-objections would be withdrawn by the parties.

made bound by the terms and conditions of the compromise.
