ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.33 dated 13.06.2019, under Sections 307, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Kacha Pacca, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is a case of no injury as it is alleged in the FIR that gun shot was fired by the petitioner but it did not hit anyone. The petitioner is in custody for over 3 months since July, 2019 and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Naib Singh, states that although investigation has been completed but no witness has been examined. He, however, is not in a position to controvert the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when no injury was caused to anyone, he is not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
