Learned State counsel on instructions from the police official who is present in Court today to assist him, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and presently his custodial interrogation is not required.

However, counsel for the petitioner submits that upon joining investigation, in fact the investigating officer had told the petitioner that he had been declared to be a Proclaimed Offender on 23.07.2019, which he submits the petitioner was never aware of.

Be that as it may, without making any comment on that contention, with learned State counsel in fact submitting again, on instructions, that the petitioner has not been declared to be a Proclaimed Offender, and the aforesaid police official who is present in Court to assist him, also stating that his custodial interrogation is not required, the order dated 16.09.2019 is made absolute.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
