Prayer in this petition is for setting aside order dated 20.03.2018 passed by the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Charki Dadri whereby the present petitioners were proceeded exparte as well as order dated 04.09.2019 whereby present petitioners' application for setting aside exparte proceedings qua them, has been dismissed. It is specifically observed by the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Charki Dadri that a period of three months had been afforded by the Hon'ble Supreme Court to judgment-debtor No. 4 to vacate the premises in question and the stand of the petitioners from the very beginning was that apart from judgment-debtor Nos. 1 and 4 none other had any concern with the shop in question.
