Petitioner-Bikramjit Singh @ Bikka prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.123 dated 09.11.2018 registered under Sections 302, 307, 324, 323, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3(2), (5), (Va) SC/ST Atrocities Act at Police Station Sadar, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner while referring to the First Information Report has submitted that although petitioner was alleged to be armed with *dattar*, however, petitioner has not caused any injury to anyone. He further submits that on 14.11.2018, statement of injured was recorded who has stated that the petitioner had given injury to the deceased on the finger of right hand with blunt side of *dattar*. He further submits that petitioner is in custody since 29.11.2018.

On 25.09.2019, bail application was adjourned enabling first informant-injured to complete his examination. This Court has been informed that application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. has been filed and, therefore, cross-examination of the injured could not be recorded.

As per the information supplied by the counsel for the State, petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
