The present appeal has been directed against award dated 23.8.2019 passed by the Railway Claims Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench, Chandigarh (in short "the Tribunal"), whereby 10% of compensation awarded to major claimant namely Ramesh Yadav was paid and the rest i.e. Rs.2,70,000/- along with interest was ordered to be invested in Bank to be transferred in account of claimant No.1 in 54 consecutive months at the rate of Rs.5000/- per month.

The precise question involved in this case is whether the Tribunal has rightly ordered for investing of compensation allowed to adult claimant(s) in fixed deposit or otherwise.

The controversy raised in the present appeal is squarely covered by judgment of this court in **Amarjeet Singh and another**

vs.Union of India through General Manager FAO No. 2037 of 2019
and connected cases decided on 4.9.2019.

Disposed of in the same terms.
