The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.124 dated 12.04.2019, under Sections 420, 468, 471, 482 IPC and Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Sector 56, Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is 21 years of age and the allegations against the petitioner are that he was driver of the vehicle wherefrom 230 boxes of liquor were recovered. It is also alleged that the front number plate indicated that the vehicle was registered in Haryana while the rear number plate was of Uttar Pradesh. He also states that the petitioner is not involved in any other case and is in custody for over six months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Ajit Singh, states that although investigation has been completed but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is 21 years of age, he is in custody for over six months, he is not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
