The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.88 dated 10.08.2019 under Sections 61/1/14 of Excise Act, registered at Police Station Khanauri, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 17.09.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Tarsem Lal, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 17.09.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
