ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.457 dated 21.06.2019, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 & 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Model Town, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and the allegations are primarily against the co-accused Jaswinder Singh who is accused of having raised the insurance claim by falsely reporting the theft of the vehicle. The petitioner was arraigned as an accused as the postal address of the petitioner has been given by the co-accused Jaswinder Singh who is the brother in law of the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody for almost 3 months since his arrest in July, 2019. He is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Surender Singh, states that although investigation has been completed but the charges are yet to be framed.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for almost 3 months, he is not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
