ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 205 dated 12.06.2019, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC registered at Police Station PGIMS, District Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he is alleged to have taken money for the admission of the son of the complainant in a medical college at Haldwani. He further contends that the petitioner himself was a victim as his daughter had also to take admission and the petitioner had deposited a large sum of money to one Veneet who is the nephew of the petitioner. He also contends that without prejudice to his rights and contentions, the petitioner, who is a teacher in a government senior secondary school, has paid a sum of Rs.7 lakh to the complainant.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that the petitioner is required to pay more money as the money had been paid in cash to the petitioner who had promised to get the son of the complainant admitted in medical college through one Vineet who is the nephew of the petitioner.

This Court, by the order dated 23.10.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Rajinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 23.10.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
