The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.108 dated 24.04.2019, under Sections 379-B/411/201 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had snatched a mobile phone from the complainant. He further contends that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case as he was earlier involved in another case and on the alleged statement of the petitioner while in the custody in other case, he has been falsely involved in this case also. He has already been granted bail in other case bearing FIR No.133 dated 23.5.2019 under Sections 379-B (2) IPC, P.S. Sadar, Amritsar. The petitioner is 20 years of age and is in custody for over 5-1/2 months.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI-Hardeep Singh states that although charges have been framed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when he is in custody for almost 5-1/2 months and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
