On 17.09.2019, following order was passed:-

“Petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in FIR No.235 dated 22.07.2019 registered under Sections 406/420/506 and Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station, Arya Nagar, Rohtak. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is only a marginal witness of the sale deed which was registered in favour of the first informant. He further submits that petitioner is not related to Nirmala, wife of Suresh, vendor of the sale-deed.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr.Anmol Malik, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice. A copy of the petition be handed over to him, during the course of the day.

List on 08.11.2019.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to

do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Parkash Chand, has submitted that the petitioner in this case has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 17.09.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
