Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.11, dated 16.01.2019, registered under Sections 323/341/34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), at Police Station Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for 2 months 5 days. Investigations are complete. Final report has been submitted in Court. He further submits that co-accused of the petitioner has been granted concession of bail.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh, has submitted that the petitioner is a main accused, who had given a fist blow on the left eye of the injured due to which there is a severe damage to the eye.

Petitioner was only wearing 'Kara' which caused the injury. 'Kara' is normally worn by the Sikhs. Hence, it cannot be said that the petitioner had come armed.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody for 02 months and 05 days and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate

surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
