Main case

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of direction to respondents to take action against private respondents in case FIR No.224 dated 20.03.2017 registered under Sections 120-B, 406, 420 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Chandni Bagh, Panipat.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Jai Ram has apprised the Court that in all there are three accused and one of them, namely, Yashpal Singh has been granted the concession of regular bail. He

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further submits that in respect of the other two co-accused, namely, Ramesh and Krishan Lal, arrest warrants have been issued and investigation is in progress.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the prayer and prays for withdrawal of the petition at this stage.
