On 17.09.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in FIR No.202 dated 14.07.2019 registered under Sections 279, 323, 336, 427, 506, 34 IPC and 27/54/59 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Kosli, District Rewari.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the main accused Sanjay Kumar son of Raj Pal was arrested and pistol (licensed weapon) has already been recovered.

Notice of motion for 30.10.2019.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Munish Bansal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State. A copy of the petition be handed-over to him during the course of the day.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing

personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Sombir, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, order dated 17.09.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
