In reference to the judgment and order dated 20.01.2017, rendered in CWP No.4393 of 2014 (**Gurjit Singh v. Financial Commissioner (Revenue), Punjab and others**), learned counsel for the respondents submits that the present appeal is rendered infructuous and the same be disposed of as such.

In response, learned counsel for the appellants submits that despite repeated communications and even reminders, neither the appellants nor anyone on their behalf has contacted his office, though in the wake of the order dated 20.01.2017 nothing indeed survives for determination in this appeal.
