The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.63 dated 04.04.2019, registered under Sections 307, 427, 148, 149 IPC and 25 and 27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Division B, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

The operative part of the order dated 20.09.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioners, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the matter has already been compromised between the parties and in CRM-M-33914-2019, praying for quashing of aforesaid FIR, on the basis of compromise, notice of motion has been issued for 11.11.2019.

Learned counsel for the complainants has not disputed the factual position, however, it is submitted that in terms of the compromise, co-accused Tejpreet Singh has

already been granted the concession of regular bail vide order dated 23.07.2019 passed in CRM-M-30024-2019....”

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 20.09.2019, the petitioners have appeared before the Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurmeet Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 20.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
